When researching programs, remember to ask program staff to connect you with former participants so that you can learn about their experience directly from them. All students who plan to participate in a Non-Harvard International Program - whether the organization is listed here or not - must fill out a Health, Safety, and Security Information Form (available on the Summer Funding section of the OCS website) for review by Harvard's Global Support Services (GSS) Office. Programs that are not approved by GSS or under 8 weeks in duration will not be eligible to receive OCS summer funding. Programs must operate as a not-for-profit and this category is not intended to support any for-credit or study abroad programs.
